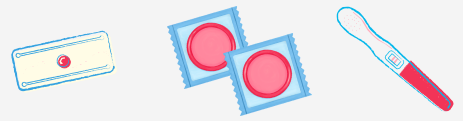


PHARMACY VERSION

**Free condoms and pregnancy testing for  
13-24 year olds in B&NES**

**Does the  
young person  
have a C-card?**

If not:  
If they are 16+ signpost them to  
safebanes.com to register for a  
virtual Ccard.

13-15 year olds need to sign up  
with a professional (school nurse,  
youth club, sexual health clinic),  
see safebanes.com for details.

**Check in with  
the young  
person**

Are they okay, do they need  
any further contraceptive  
advice? Do they need a  
chlamydia test?

**Complete any  
actions or referrals  
as necessary**

Are there any  
safeguarding issues?

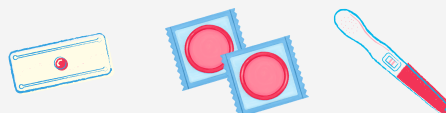
**Give products  
as needed**

internal condoms, lubricant, etc..

PharmOutcomes to be  
eligible for payment



## Consultation costings 2025-26

- £2.50 per supply of condoms
- £3.50 per pregnancy test issued

**Condoms supplies and pregnancy tests don't need  
to be administered by clinical staff**

We have lots of facilitators across sectors working with young people  
and any suitably trained staff member can do this, as long as they  
have access to Pharmoutcomes and can record interactions.

Young people should take the pregnancy testing kit away with them.  
Do not get involved in decision making, discussion of options or  
interpretation of results. For positive pregnancy tests, young people  
should be signposted to the Riverside Clinic, their GP, or Clinic in a  
Box (school nursing) for information on choices.

## Free EHC

As of October 2025, Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC) is  
available free of charge from community pharmacies across B&NES to
